Inclement Weather information for all volunteers

In the event of inclement weather, the event will be a rain/shine event except for severe weather conditions.

Event Routes: If a change in the event course is required, the Race Chair or designate must be available and be prepared to make changes. If poor weather conditions or water conditions threaten the safety of racers an alternate route should be available if reasonable. Volunteers assigned to the site, if changed will go to the alternate site as described.

Weather conditions for consideration include:

Rain:

Action: Increased frequency of dynamic hazard assessment for race start and take out points.

Significant wind conditions/rough water:

Paddling consultants will support the requirement for route diversion. If required, all or designated paddlecraft will be given the opportunity to alter their route.

Alternate route: 17 km route Snye (Nautical Nest or Ecarte (?) Marina) to Sydenham Route bypasses need to be in the St Clair River in the event of high winds and/or rough water

Severe storm including Lightning:

Weather outlook will determine the ability to hold the event. No event shall start in a thunderstorm

The chair will consider altering the start time of the event if there is potential to bypass weather.
